2. Definitions:

data set: the sum of the data managed in one register

data processing: performing technical tasks related to data processing operations, irrespective of the method and means used to carry out the operations and the place of application, provided that the technical task is performed on the task

data processor: any natural or legal person, or an organization without legal personality who carries out the processing of data on the basis of a contract concluded with the data controller, including under a legal provision

data management: any operation or set of operations, whether automated or not, carried out on personal data or files, including through the collecting, recording, systematizing, subdividing, storing, transforming or altering, retrieving, accessing, using, transmitting, distributing or otherwise making available, coordinating or linking, limiting, deleting or destroying

data controller: any natural or legal person, or an organization without legal personality, who either alone or jointly with others determines the purpose of the processing of data, makes and implements data management decisions (including the devices used), or implements with a data processor authorized by the controller

data identification: the identification of the data in order to distinguish it

data destruction: the complete physical destruction of the data medium containing the data

data transfer: making data available to a specific third party

data deletion: making data unrecognizable in such a way that it is no longer possible to recover it

data blocking: marking the data with an identification mark to limit its further processing for a definite or definite period of time;

data subject: any natural person identified - directly or indirectly, on the basis of personal data;

contribution: a voluntary and determined expression of the will of the data subject, based on appropriate information and giving his / her unambiguous consent to the processing of personal data concerning him / her, whether full or specific;

personal data: data which may be related to the data subject, in particular the data subject's name, an identification mark and knowledge of one or more physical, physiological, mental, economic, cultural or social identities, and the conclusion that the data subject may draw

objection: a statement by the data subject objecting to the processing of his / her personal data and requesting the finishing of the data processing or the deletion of the data processed.

3. Personal data management, data security:

3.1 Governing Law

The Data Controller is committed to the protection of personal data at all times in accordance with the applicable laws (in particular REGULATION (EU) 2016/679 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 27 April 2016) on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Regulation (EC) No 95/46 ("the General Data Protection Regulation") (henceforth: GDPR) and Act CXII of 2011 on the Protection of Personal Data and the Publicity of Public Data in force in Hungary Act (henceforth: Info tv.) acts properly.

3.2 The scope of personal data, the purpose, legal basis and duration of the data processing

3.2.1 *Newsletter*

Purpose of Data Management: To raise awareness of Art Service Provider events. Art service providers are sending out a joint newsletter.
Scope of data managed: name, email, phone number (optional).
Duration of data processing: Withdrawal of consent.
Legal basis for data processing: voluntary consent of the data subject (Article 6 (1) a) GDPR)

3.2.2 *Internal communication of choir activities*

Purpose of data management: Organization and operation of the choir.
Scope of data managed: name, email, phone number (optional).
Duration of data processing: Withdrawal of consent.
Legal basis for data processing: voluntary consent of the data subject (Article 6 (1) a) GDPR)

3.2.3 *Applications for ImPulse - Creative Music Lab trainings*

3.2.3.1 Purpose of data management: Preparation, organization and communication of training before and after the training

Scope of data managed: name, email, phone number.

Duration of data processing: Withdrawal of consent.

Legal basis for data management: performance of contract for training or preparation of contract (Article 6 (1) b) GDPR)

3.2.3.2 Purpose of Data Management: Billing

Scope of data managed: Billing data.

Duration of data management: According to the Accounting Act.

Legal basis for data management: legal obligation to comply with the Accounting Act (Article 6 (1) c) GDPR)

3.3 Data Processors

3.5 Data subject's rights

The data subject may request information on the processing of his / her personal data and may request the correction or deletion of his / her personal data, with the exception of the mandatory data management, deletion in the manner indicated at the time of data collection or at the contact details of the controller. You can initiate a request for information, correction or deletion of your personal information by email: hangkelto@gmail.com.

At the request of the data subject, the controller shall provide information on the data processed by the data controller or on his / her behalf, the source, the purpose, legal basis, duration, name, address, and its data processing activities and, in case of data transfer, its legal basis and addressee. The controller shall provide the information in writing within a maximum of 30 days from the submission of the request. This information shall be free of charge if the person requesting the information has not yet submitted an information request to the controller for the same scope in the current year. In other cases, the controller will charge a fee.

The data controller has 30 days to delete, block or correct the personal data. If the controller does not comply with the data subject's request for correction, blocking or deletion, the controller shall notify its reasons for the rejection in writing within 30 days.

The data subject may object to the processing of his / her personal data if

- a) processing or transferring personal data is only necessary for the fulfilment of a legal obligation to which the controller is subject or is necessary to assert the legitimate interest of the controller, the recipient or a third party, unless such processing is required by law.
- b) the personal data is used or transmitted for the purpose of direct marketing, survey making or scientific research; or c) in other cases specified by law.

The controller shall investigate the objection within a maximum of 15 days from the submission of the application, make a decision on its merits and inform the applicant in writing of the decision. If the controller determines that the objection of the data subject is well founded, the data processing,

including further data collection and transmission, shall be removed and the data shall be blocked, and anyone who has previously communicated personal information about the data subject shall be notified, and who is required to take action to enforce the right of the data subject.

If the data subject does not agree with the decision of the controller, he / she may, within 30 days of being informed, bring the matter to court.

The data controller may not delete the data of the data subject if the data processing has been ordered by law. However, the data may not be forwarded to the recipient if the controller has agreed to the objection or the court has found the objection as justified.

In case of a violation of his / her rights, the data subject may sue the controller, which will be dealt out of turn.
